2012 Veuve Clicquot Gold Cup: Tough, wet conditions at Cowdray Park sunday in the final of the Veuve Clicquot Gold Cup had Cortium and El Remanso fight the heavy ground early in their game to a 3-3 time at halftime with balls decelerating quickly on the approach to goal or missing narrowly as the field's thick moisture played tricks on players hitting off the ground.

A large crowd invaded the torn field at halftime doing an excellent job putting the field back together for a very good second half. El Remanso, being a very agile Pelon Sterling and a superb goal (offside backander with a lot of English) by Charlie Hanbury late fifth for 8-7, took the lead several times, Cortium fighting back and tying the score repeatedly, led by MVP Polito Pieres showing great determination and scoring 8 of Cortium 10 goals for the win 10-9.




