ark Bellissimo announced yesterday that the Wellington Equestrian Partners (WEP) had completed the purchase of the International Polo Club (IPC) in Wellington, FL.

IPC is the storied home of High Goal Polo during the winter season in Wellington, FL, for the last 14 years with competition beginning in January and continuing through the end of April each year. Says Mark Bellissimo: "WEP's primary goal is to ensure that IPC remains one of the world's premier Polo Clubs and a key economic driver of Wellington's equestrian economy.

"The WEP partnership will be expending significant resources to ensure that the facilities and the polo fields are second to none and are committed to maintaining the same High Goal Polo calendar for 2017 and beyond."

IPC's main stadium venue and polo activity are complemented by a private club with spa, fitness center, tennis courts, pool, as well as The Mallet Grille restaurant and The 7th Chukker lounge.
