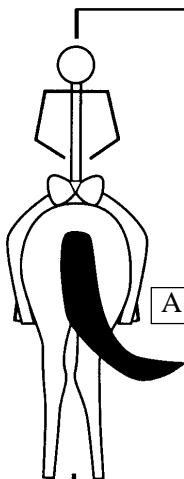

**NEW, PERPETUAL TROPHY FOR
NEW CLUB BY MITCHELL PECK**

The studios of Mitchell-Peck have been creating museum quality jewelry and object d'art since 1991, but all work has been put on hold since July 2003 for the project of epic proportion that has occupied the attention of Master Goldsmith Philip Peck: A spectacular new trophy for the new International Polo Club Palm Beach.

Mitchell-Peck has pulled all the stops to create a perpetual cup worthy of the mission of the new club: "to re-establish the grandeur and integrity of Polo in South Florida."

Inspired by trophies created in the 19th Century, the cup stands 24 inches tall and boasts a full team of polo players with

heads bowed reverentially, busts of horses in full tack, decorated plinths, and a hand raised bowl 14 inches in diameter.

To create the cup, the studio built its own sterling silver foundry, and had to bring some raw material from England. In Philip's words, "we have such respect for the efforts of John Goodman, and have endeavored to embody those ideals in a work of art that will represent the best of both our worlds."

and is currently featured in a group exhibition at the National Museum of Polo and Hall of Fame next to Wellington, in Lake Worth, Florida.

Melinda's work has been exhibited at several Canadian and U.S. polo tournaments, and she has been acclaimed and recognized by many polo players, polo enthusiasts and polo art collectors.

Her work is highly regarded by many because of her understanding and sensitive portraiture of the horse, real-life depiction of the game of polo and, of course, the individual detail captured in each

watercolor painting. It has been said that "the eyes are the reflection of the soul and the reflection in the liquid eyes of Melinda's horses do indeed seem to come alive, reaching to the very depth of the inner being."

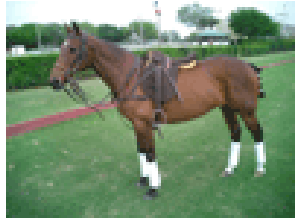

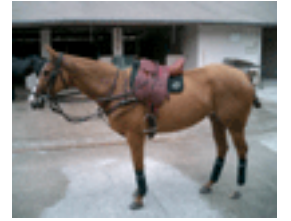

PROFESSIONAL POLO LEAGUE TO START THIS SUMMER IN ENGLAND

On the 100th Anniversary of the U.S. Open Polo Championship, Polo in Britain might go into a new era with the British Polo Championship reserved to professional polo players, a new tournament format which the organizers hope will also enable more British players to hone their skills.

The new British Polo Championship series gets off the ground this Summer. The series is being run by British Polo Enterprises (BPE).

Derrick Chow, a BPE director explains: "Ultimately, we want this to be the event that every British player wants to play in the polo season over here, though no restriction has been placed on nationality." BPE hopes that the scheme will herald the dawn of a new era for the structure of polo in Britain, which is different to patron-based polo.

Chow continues: "We've been hindered by a feudalistic structure which is dependent on a few very rich patrons. We don't want to jeopardize that in any way, but as many British players can no longer rely on patrons for their livelihood, we want to provide a playing structure that allows them to enhance their game while playing professionally."

Jason Dixon, chairman of the British Association of Professional Polo Players agrees that the aim of the new venture is to "complement the existing, patron-based tournaments: it shouldn't be one against the other."

Four teams of five-goal players or higher will play for the title – as well as substantial prize money – with four-chukker semi-finals and finals at Coworth Park, Berkshire, on Friday 9 and Saturday 31 July respectively.

BPE has asked four English high-goalers to captain the teams: Henry Brett (8), Will Lucas (7), Roddy Williams (6) and Andrew Hine (7). Other players will be invited to join the teams at the end of April, and team handicaps will be at least 23 goals. email: bpc@BritishPolo.com

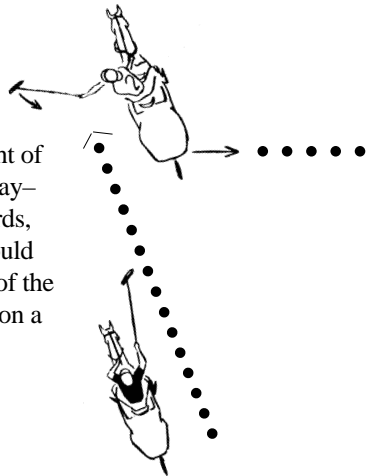

RULES OF POLO

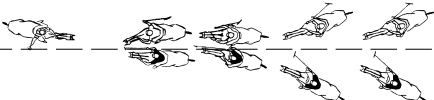
Polo games last six chukkers of 7 minutes each, with halftime rest during third and fourth chukkers. A team has four players. Players come back with a fresh mount after each chukker.

Running the length on both sides of the field is an 11"- high wooden board that keeps the ball in play. If the ball goes out of bounds (on the sideline) the umpire orders the players to line-up in front of him and throw the ball in from that point where the ball left the field.

A typical defensive play for White. While Black is galloping forward on the line of the ball with the Right of Way, White-ahead of the play-can back the ball to the boards, away from his goal (but should stay on that side of the line of the ball to prevent being called on a crossing foul).

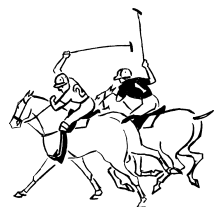


Open-angle offside forehand to pass the ball to a teammate from left to right or to shoot on goal.



Bowl-in: a game always begins with the umpire throwing the ball towards the players lined-up on either side of the halfway line.

Players line-up again after a goal has been scored, and change ends to allow fairness of sides and conditions (wind, sun and ground), much like in tennis for example.

Teams change ends after each goal is scored.

Goal posts stand 8 yards (24 feet) apart

A polo field is 300 yard long and 150 yard wide, the size of nine football fields. The grass is kept as smooth and even as possible to allow the horses to safely gallop at speed up to 35 m.p.h.

The game is refereed by two mounted umpires (a third man is also officiating from the side). Fouls are called on dangerous riding, illegal bumping, crossing and bad hook, rough or abusive play and appealing for a foul. Most of the fouls, though, will be called on *crossing the line*.
